Riding for the Disabled Association of Western Australia – Carine Group Inc. combines the transformative power and the therapeutic effects of horse riding. This is achieved by the provision of equestrian activities that expand the horizons, develop the abilities and enrich the lives of individuals with varying abilities and additional needs.

The warmth and three dimensional movement of the horse is transferred to the rider's body, making it more relaxed and supple, strengthening core stability and improving balance, posture and coordination.

RDA Carine programs include Therapeutic Riding; Hippotherapy; Vaulting; Leading Reins Corporate Training and Own a Horse for the Day School Holiday Camp.

We offer Therapeutic Riding sessions from Monday through to Saturday and Hippotherapy sessions on Monday and Wednesday mornings both throughout the school terms.

RDA Carine is an Unregistered NDIS Provider complying with all relevant rules and regulations, including the NDIS Code of Conduct, Riding for the Disabled Australia (RDAA) regulations, Sport Integrity Australia National Integrity Framework Policies and RDA Carine Policies and Procedures. Participants whose NDIS Plans are Selfmanaged and Plan-managed can use their funds to access our Equine Therapeutic Riding Program services.

Our professional and highly specialised Program support services are run by RDAA Nationally qualified and accredited Coaches.

The session Support Fee is for the costs associated with the specialised support services we provide for children and adults with a disability to access our Equine Therapeutic Riding program activity, not for the horse-riding activity itself.

RDA Carine services have been categorised as recreational activities. NDIS funds for our Equine Therapeutic Riding Program are allocated from the NDIS Plan Core Supports Budget under the line item Assistance to access Community, Social and Recreational Activities (Item Ref No: 04_104_0125_6_1). The Capacity Building Supports Budget funds may be used by Self-managed and Plan-managed participants.
